2. FIRST AID MEASURES

EYES: Flush immediately with water, continuing for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists get medical attention.

SKIN: Flush with plenty of soap and water, removing contaminated clothing. If irritation develops, get medical attention.

INHALATION: Promptly remove to fresh air.

INGESTION: If conscious, immediately give a large quantity of water or milk. If not already vomiting, induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Get medical attention.

3. HAZARDS INFORMATION

INHALATION:

Dust or mist inhalation at levels above the TLV listed below may irritate respiratory tract.

INGESTION:

Ingestion may irritate gastrointestinal tract. LD50 (mouse) = approximately 10.8 g/kg (slightly toxic). Reference (a) May cause nausea, vomiting, or purging. Human fatal dose recorded at grams (ref c).

SKIN:

May cause skin irritation, especially under repeated or prolonged contact, or when moisture is present.

EYES:

May irritate or burn eyes. Similarly for the aqueous solution.

PERMISSIBLE CONCENTRATION:

TLV: 2 mg AL/cu.m . (OSHA and ACGIH)

4. PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

Respiratory Protection:

Where required, use a respirator approved by NIOSH for dust or mists.

Eyes and Face:

Wear hard hat (or other head covering) and chemical safety goggles. Do not wear contact lenses.

Hands, Arms and Body:

Wear gloves and other appropriate industrial work clothing, including shirt and trousers for routine product handling use. These should be exchanged for impervious ones if handling solutions and there is repeated or prolonged contact.
